Why Viet Nam and Da Nang?



Viet Nam is a strategically relevant host for APWSS 2027 because its agriculture includes intensive rice-based systems, upland crops, vegetables, fruit crops, aquaculture-integrated landscapes and rapidly changing production environments.

Da Nang combines modern conference infrastructure, beachside hospitality, convenient domestic and international access, and cultural proximity to central Viet Nam. It is a practical and memorable setting for regional scientific exchange.

THEME, SCOPE AND OBJECTIVES

Conference Theme

Weed Research and Management under Global Climate Change

The theme recognizes that rising temperatures, variable rainfall, extreme weather events, altered production systems and environmental pressures are reshaping weed distribution, crop-weed interactions, herbicide performance and management sustainability.

Scientific exchange Present recent advances in weed biology, ecology, evolution, genetics and management.	Climate resilience Address climate-driven changes in weed dynamics, invasiveness and crop-weed competition.
Sustainable management Strengthen integrated weed management across rice, upland, non-crop, aquatic and organic systems.	Innovation and capacity building Highlight precision agriculture, remote sensing, AI, education and knowledge transfer for young scientists.

- Weed scientists, agronomists, ecologists, plant biologists and crop protection researchers
- University lecturers, graduate students, young scientists and postdoctoral researchers

Expected Outcomes

Participants are expected to gain updated scientific knowledge, identify collaboration opportunities, engage with innovative weed management tools, and contribute to a shared vision for sustainable, climate-resilient weed science in the Asia-Pacific region.

Authors will be invited to submit original work relevant to weed science, crop protection, sustainable agriculture, environmental management or related disciplines aligned with the conference thematic areas.
